Le Dr^e José Pereira



Dr. José Pereira is co-founder and Scientific Officer of Pallium Canada. He is Director of Research at the College of Family Physicians of Canada. He is also Gilchrist Chair and Professor of Palliative Medicine at Queen's University and holds academic appointments in the Departments of Family Medicine at McMaster University and the University of Ottawa. Dr. Pereira's research and education work has included developing primary-level palliative care capacity. More recently at the College he is leading the implementation of a national quality improvement and practice-level data use initiative. He is widely published with over 90 peer-reviewed publications, book chapters and books, including the Pallium Palliative Pocketbook.

Maryse Bouvette

Maryse Bouvette is an advanced practice nurse specialized in palliative care. She is presently working as Coordinator of the Ministry of Health, Regional Palliative Consultation Team (RPCT) with the Bruyère Continuing Care since 1998. Maryse was co-chair of the Education group with the National Strategy on Palliative and End of Life Care and also co-chair of the Canadian Hospice Palliative Care Nursing Certification committee with the Canadian Nurses Association. She recently won the Bafour Mount Award of Excellence from the Canadian Hospice Palliative Care Association. She is also author of a few articles and chapters in clinical palliative care.
