The Catholic Health Association of New Brunswick held its annual conference in Miramichi on September 19th and 20th. There we 95 registrants from 12 Catholic Health International Sponsored facilities in New Brunswick. The theme of the conference was "The Faces of Homelessness" with four excellent speakers who work in the field in New Brunswick



Greg Bishop, a Senior Director from the Human Development Council (HDC) led off the conference with in depth overview of recent research on homelessness in New Brunswick. On the second day of the conference Marc Belliveau, Senior Director of Philanthropy, Government Relations and Strategic partnerships with Harvest House Atlantic - Moncton (HHA) presented on the theme "How we properly support those most vulnerable." The final two presenters where from the YWCA in Moncton, Michéle Nadeau, CEO and Tara Hosford, Housing Case Manager. Their theme was "Women's Housing Needs & Homelessness." Tara gave a particularly inspiring and moving first person account of living with homelessness. The CHANB Board and staff want to thank the presenters for their inspiring work and for the challenge to find ways to advocate for those working in the homelessness field. CHANB LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD





The Opening presentation was titled *Trinity and Divinity - What Does the Triune God Have to Do with Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, and Belonging?* by Rev. Dr. Darren Dias, Ph.D. O.P., Executive Director, Toronto School of Theology followed by Patricia O'Campo, Ph.D., from Unity Health and Claire Barcik, Executive Director, Catherine Donnelly Foundation who presented *Equity: What it is and Why it Matters*. Peter J. Cataldo, Ph.D., an ethicist from New Hampshire, gave a very important presentation on *Catholic teaching and the care of persons with gender dysphoria in Catholic health care*. Adam Shaen and Paul Francis, both Vice Presidents from the St. Joseph's Care Group, in Thunder Bay presented on *Walking with Humility and Creating a Culture of Belonging*. The final speaker was Anna Greenberg, Executive Director & COO from Ontario Health who gave an overview of their work. The Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, as a follow up to the *International Interfaith Symposium on Palliative Care: Towards a Narrative of Hope*" has released its anticipated Statement and Recommendations as a key concrete outcome of the event which took place from 21 to 23 May 2024. The Symposium, organized by the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) in partnership with the Pontifical Academy for Life (PAV), as well as other collaborators, was one of the first of its kind in terms of charting new paths for the promotion and expansion of palliative care. 
